What is the purpose of this program?

This program is established by the Valdez City Council to provide a one-time economic relief payment to qualifying Valdez households and businesses who have been adversely impacted by the COVID-19 Health Emergency.

Business	One application per distinct business; you may submit multiple applications ; Business applicants must have a valid City of Valdez business license as of April 15, 2020; Businesses must have a distinct Federal Tax ID number, unless a sole-proprietorship; Sole-proprietorships may not share an address with a "household" applicant; Applicant must complete and sign IRS form W9 on page 2 of this application
